Practising certificate and registration renewals will take place from 1 to 31 October 2025 (inclusive).

#### Checking mySRA

Ahead of renewals, it is important that everyone checks their mySRA details. It is essential that the information we hold is accurate and complete for all firms and individuals we regulate.

### Changes to verifying your identify in mySRA

When logging in, alongside entering your password, you need to verify your identity by entering a code. We have further improved the security of mySRA by switching to app-based verification.

Instead of receiving a code by text message, you'll use an authenticator app to generate it. We suggest using either the Microsoft Authenticator or Google Authenticator. Or you can use another authenticator app if you
